Late registrants will be allowed to attend only if space is available. The registration fee is \$50.

Participants should bring sufficient funds for a dinner meal each evening, for meals while traveling and for incidental expenses. Those attending will receive complimentary two night's accommodations at the Omni Mandalay Hotel; however the hotel will expect a credit card or cash deposit for telephone calls, meals charged to the room and movies.
